

South Hanover Township Public Works Director

The Township of South Hanover, located in Dauphin County, is seeking applications for the position of Public Works Director.

The Public Works Director will oversee and work alongside the Public Works Staff. In addition, the Director of Public Works will be involved in stormwater maintenance, road maintenance and improvements, snow removal, township buildings and grounds maintenance, and parks and athletic fields maintenance. An in-depth knowledge of scheduling, seasonal operations for local government, budget preparation, bid specifications, procurement, and operations are necessary.

A college degree is preferred but not required. Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED equivalent, formal training, and education in public works administration with a minimum of three years hands-on documented supervisory experience in a public works environment with a valid PA Driver's License and current CDL License.
