JOB SUMMARY

This is skilled operational position performing manual tasks in connection with maintaining the township's infrastructure, properties and equipment – specifically road construction, maintenance and repair of facilities, buildings, grounds and parks, public sewers, and other repair projects. Individual must have the ability to follow instructions, perform labor tasks, possess a working knowledge and skill level in operating and maintaining various trucks, construction, specialized equipment, and possess a working knowledge of general maintenance procedures.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Performs semi-skilled and skilled work in operations, maintenance and repair on all township properties, roadways and facilities, which may include: general construction and maintenance involving; groundskeeping, housekeeping, upkeep, new installations and repair.

Winter maintenance as required; operation of township equipment to plow and de-ice roadways.

Assist in maintaining, repairing and constructing township road systems; including loading and unloading trucks, spreading asphalt, gravel and dirt, raking, tamping and smoothing applied materials.

Grade along township roads for proper drainage. Clean, maintain and repair culverts, drains, ditches and water easements.

Operate trucks, construction, and specialized equipment skillfully and safely. Perform general repairs and preventive maintenance of vehicles and equipment.

Perform general landscaping and tree maintenance on Twp property and along township roads.

Assist in the general maintenance of Plumbing, HVAC, Electrical projects and general building maintenance.

Performs other duties as assigned.

Must have the ability to safely climb equipment and ladders and be comfortable with heights. Must have ability to perform physical activities that require considerable use of arms, legs and moving of whole body.
