Stormwater Technician

Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County, PA is seeking a full-time Stormwater Technician to assist with implementation of and satisfaction of the requirements of the Township's Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit and Stormwater Management Program under the general direction of Stormwater Management Program Coordinator.

The successful candidate must possess a high school diploma/GED and at least one year of experience, or an equivalent combination of education or experience which indicates possession of skills, knowledge, and abilities listed below. An example of acceptable qualifications for this position is experienced in environmental permitting, stormwater drainage, and stormwater management facility construction. If no work experience, two years of education in environmental science, sustainability, water resources, or related fields. This applicant may also have at least six months experience in Geographic Information Systems, or related software, including field mapping and data collection. Any experience in manipulating data and generating documentation is preferred.

Must either possess or obtain certification as NPDES Certified Stormwater Inspector Certification and Chesapeake Bay Landscape Professional Crews and Buffer Certifications within first year of employment, based on course availability.
